
SEATING

- Tickets are <u>NOT</u> needed for the event
- <u>NO</u> restriction on amount of guests
- Doors open <u>ONE HOUR</u> prior to the graduation ceremony
- Seating at Moby Arena is first come/first serve
- Reserving seats is <u>NOT</u> allowed
- There are <u>NO</u> wheelchairs available for use
- ONLY ONE individual can sit with handicapped guest
- Parents = Ask your graduate which side they are sitting on at Moby <u>after rehearsal</u>

- First Two Rows reserved for wheelchairs and handicapped guests
- Foriegn Language Interpreters are located in Section M
- Hearing-impaired guests are asked to sit in Section N

Important note:

Families are asked to refrain from reserving a large number of seats using tape or signs to block off sections. Seating throughout the arena is first-come, first-served.

PARKING & SECURITY

- CSU requires that all guests and employees pass through a metal detector. Alternative accommodations for screening will be provided for those who need it. All personal items, including cameras, must go through the metal detectors. Guests who refuse screening will be denied entry.
- Please read the Prohibited Items section carefully.
- Concealed weapons permits will not be allowed. An off-duty officer with identification can come in. Their location will be tracked.
- Please read their "CLEAR BAG POLICY" carefully and make appropriate changes to your arrival time and be prepared to be patient entering Moby Arena
- Hard and/or non-transparent water bottles are not allowed
- <u>May 25th Event Parking</u> = Attendants will direct students, staff and families to free parking in lots to the West and North of Moby.



COLORADO STATE ATHLETICS CLEAR BAG POLICY



APPROVED BAGS

- Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12"W x 6"D x 12"H
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar).
- Small clutch bag approximately the size of a hand (4.5" x 6.5" or smaller), with or without a handle or strap. This can be carried separately or within a plastic bag.
- Seat cushions (soft and flexible, without frames or pockets).

All other bags are prohibited when entering the venue.

PROHIBITED BAG EXAMPLES











Prohibited Items: aerosol cans: aluminum bottles: animals (service dogs and service dogs in training permitted): artificial noisemakers; balloons; bat, poles and sticks; coolers/ice chests; bicycle helmets, camera lenses larger than 4"; firearms; fireworks; flags on poles; glass bottles; illegal drugs; laser pointers; marijuana (all forms); metal cans; objects that can be used as projectiles (i.e. balls); outside food and beverages including alcohol (exceptions will be made for those with medical requirements and/or special needs); scooters, strollers, bicycles, roller skates and skateboards; tobacco products; tripods, monopods and selfie sticks; umbrellas; unauthorized video cameras; water bottles (disposable and crushable bottles, empty and without a cap are permissible); weapons; any object that might pose a risk to the guest or others.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT DRESS CODE

- Please do <u>NOT</u> wear jeans, t-shirts, athletic shoes, hiking boots or any other inappropriate attire - If you would like to wear cowboy boots, please make sure they are dress shoe quality with dress pants
- We ask that students do not decorate their caps, gowns and/or wear any item that is not provided directly by the school. The intent of our graduation is to honor the academic accomplishments that our students have earned at FRHS/PSD. (See Mr. Nye if you have a specific request.)
- Students dressed inappropriately may be denied the opportunity to participate in the graduation ceremony
- Places to store keys/phones/bags/etc. are not provided for graduates Please plan accordingly
- <u>Silver Honor Cord</u> (*Receiving tonight*)= 3.75 Adjusted GPA or Higher (Sandi Emanuel) ALL other cords will come from your Advisers

CHECKED OUT ITEMS/FINES

- Students who owe money for fees and/or do not turn in all checked out items by May 22nd can be sent to collections.
- Students can see what items are checked out and/or lost, as well as any outstanding fines.

- Students/parents should check BOTH of the URL's listed above.
- Items, particularly chargers, are often mixed up with the same item of another student. We ask that all school related equipment/books be returned to Fossil, even though barcodes may not match what shows up as checked out.
- When all items have been returned at the end of the year, everything collected will be checked in, again. Any items paid for that are later returned will be refunded.

MISC. ANNOUNCEMENTS





- High school seniors should arrive with their cap and gown- however, they should not put the cap and gown on until asked to do so.


